RattanIndia Enterprises Ltd. to acquire 100% shareholding in electric motorcycle company Revolt Motors

New Delhi, October 7, 2022: RattanIndia Enterprises Limited is pleased to announce that it is acquiring 100% shareholding in the electric motorcycles market leader Revolt Motors. The Company had earlier acquired 33.84% shareholding in Revolt with an option to further increase the shareholding.

Revolt Motors is the highest selling electric motorcycles in the country and Revolters, as the proud owners of Revolt EV bikes love to call themselves have clocked in more than 100 million kms on Indian road till date. Revolt Motors is state of the art, next gen AI-enabled electric motorcycle which captures millions of data points per second to deliver great driving experience to the riders.
